- Must hold ECE Level 1 certification (minimum)

- Valid Standard First Aid and CPR (Level B or C), or willingness to obtain before starting

- Clear Child Intervention Check
- All checks must be issued within the last 6 months and satisfactory prior to employment

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Experience in implementing inclusive strategies for children with high support needs
- Experience working in a preschool or childcare setting
- A commitment to the mission and values of the Edmonton Society for Christian Education

Key Responsibilities

- Assist the Lead Teacher in delivering age-appropriate, play-based programming
- Ensure the safety and well-being of up to 20 children during play, learning, and transitions
- Model Christian values and support the spiritual growth of students
- Help prepare materials and learning spaces before class
- Assist with classroom cleanup and reset after class
- Support children's social, emotional, and physical development
- Model patience, kindness, and positive behaviour

- Maintain a safe, respectful, and nurturing environment
- Follow all licensing, health, and safety policies
- Communicate respectfully with staff and families as directed by the teacher

- Able to take direction and work collaboratively as part of a team
- Physically able to engage in classroom activities (sitting on the floor, lifting light equipment, active play)
- Comfortable working in a Christian school environment and supporting the faith-based mission of the program
